

New Brunswick Free Public Library Bulletin Boards and Literature Distribution Policy

Approved 1992, Updated February 27, 2013

The Library is a community resource providing information to the public. The Library provides not only community access to information but also welcomes notices of civic, cultural, or educational activities by community groups.

Literature will be accepted for distribution and fliers for posting on bulletin boards by the Library Director within the guidelines of this policy and upon proper application. The acceptance of materials does not imply an endorsement of the contents by the City of New Brunswick, the library or the library's Board of Trustees.

Conditions

1. The Library has the final decision on the content and display of any material. All items must be approved before posting or distribution.
2. Non-profit groups and governmental agencies may display announcements of activities which are not sectarian or of a partisan political nature.
3. No announcements of items for sale or services provided by individuals or businesses will be accepted.
4. The library reserves the right to remove any items due to space limitations.
5. No displays or distributions are allowed which create noise or which disturb the normal affairs of the Library.
6. No responsibility is assumed for any materials displayed or distributed.
7. The organization or individual providing materials for distribution or display agrees to indemnify the Library and/or the City of New Brunswick and hold the same harmless against any and all claims, demands, damages, costs and expenses, including reasonable attorneys fees for the defense of such claims, arising out of such displays.
