New Brunswick Free Public Library: Public Comment Policy

Approved Wednesday, March 23, 2005

The public may speak on any library-related issue at the Public Comment section of the agenda. Comments from the public are limited to five minutes per person, and a member of the public may only speak once per meeting. Speakers who request before the meeting to speak will be allowed to speak in the order they placed their request.

The Board may suspend the preceding rule by general consent, or by a vote of the board members present. Any motion to suspend shall specify the duration of the suspension of the rules.
